



Call for Proposals: Investigator Sponsored & Supported Collaborative Studies



GSK values collaboration with external partners that contributes to advancing medical knowledge and improved patient care. We are committed to supporting high standard ethical research conducted by external partners that aligns with shared scientific areas of interest to further understand how our medicines may be used to treat diseases and enhance patient care. There are two different ways GSK can provide support:

- **Investigator Sponsored Studies (ISS)** designed and executed by independent partners can be supported by GSK in the form of drug product, funding or a combination of both.
- **Supported Collaborative Studies (SCS)** are research sponsored and conducted by an external sponsor, which GSK might further support by contributing with study design in addition to the provision of funds and/or drug products.

2019 Submission for Respiratory Related Proposals

Submission for Supported Studies proposals will commence **17th May** for a period of 10 weeks. Following the close of the submission period, the proposals will be reviewed by the central scientific and medical teams.

GSK is committed to responding to your proposal within 8 weeks from the closing date (26th July). Decisions will be made based on the importance and innovation of the research objectives, the ability of the investigator to deliver a high-quality ethical study, and GSK's current areas of research interest as defined on the submissions portal. GSK's decision will be final as to which studies to support and GSK reserves the right to decline to support any of the proposals received.

Submission and Review Timelines:

Submission open	17th May 2019
Submission of proposal closes on the external portal	26th July 2019
Communication of decision to Sponsor Investigator by GSK	20th September 2019
Submission of initial Protocol and Informed Consent Form by Sponsor Investigator	25th October 2019

GSK is committed to deliver the above review timelines, however, the review process might take longer for certain proposals
